My mandate was to apply my industry experience to developing the school's myriad web-based IT systems. During my 3-years there I designed, developed and implemented more than a dozen IT and web systems, including:

- Migration and upgrade of the school's Moodle-based virtual learning environment (VLE) and 300+ courses.
- Unified redesign of the three public facing websites, by developing a custom 3-in-1 WordPress theme.
- Development of a new WordPress Multisite platform to support 250+ Media Studies student blogs / coursework.
- Installation of a dedicated media-streaming server (Red5) and design of a new front-end UI for the media library.

Working out of the IT Support office meant that I was often called upon to provide first-line IT support; helping staff and students with day-to-day IT hardware and networking issues.
